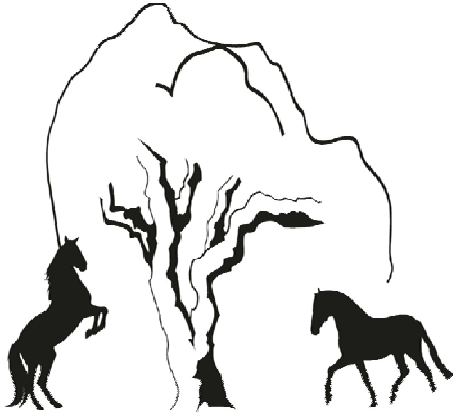

Working Cow: this event is designed to give horse and rider an allotted amount of time to work their cow in a pattern that is based on Reining Cow Horse events.

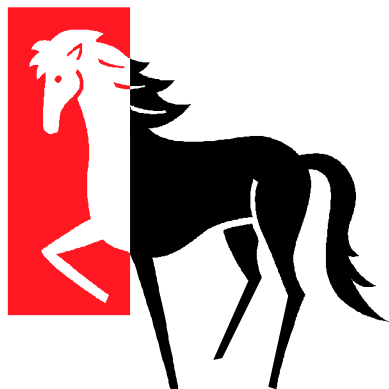
Ranch Cutting: ranch cutting is an introduction to herd work; this program is for both beginning and advanced riders and horses.
