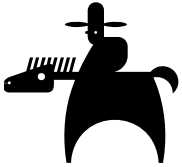

A New Season has started in Novato, and we are looking for riders, young and old who wish to join in the fun and

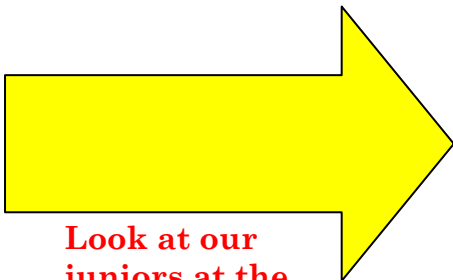
